It is a matter of pride to pen down the message for "NAME OF THE MAGZINE" the annual school Magazine of DOON WORLD PUBLIC SCHOOL.

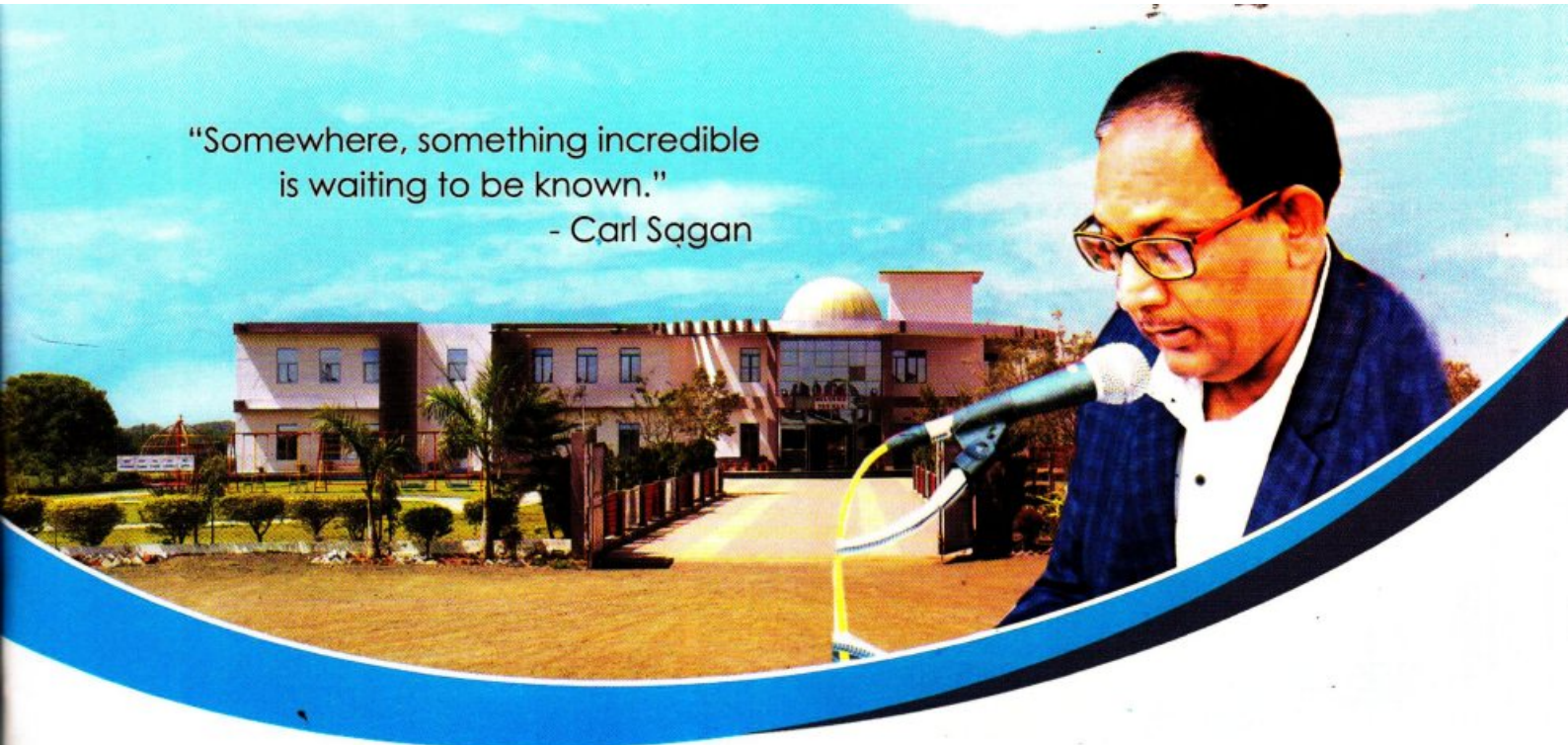

## Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru House “Red House”

**J**awahar Lal Nehru was born on 14<sup>th</sup> November 1889 at Allahabad, UP, India. His father's name was Pt. Moti Lal Nehru, who was famous lawyer. His mother's name was Swaruprani. He was brought up like a prince, after his early education at home by an English tutor, he was sent to England for higher studies. He took his degree in Law from England and returned to India as a barrister. He became a lawyer just like his father. Jawahar Lal Nehru involved in the India's freedom movement with Mahatma Gandhi. During the freedom movement he sent to jail several times. His entire life was the history of India's for freedom. He served congress for

many years as its general secretary. After independence of India in 1947 he became the first prime minister of India. Jawahar Lal Nehru was a great lover of children who loved him greatly and called him 'Chacha Nehru'. It is due to his great love for children and children's love for him, his birthday on 14<sup>th</sup> November is celebrated as “Children's Day” in our country every year. Many types of motivational activities are arranged by school students.

## Radhakrishnan House "Green House"



**D**r. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan was born on 5 September 1888 at Tircettani in Tamil Nadu. He was knighted in the year 1931 and since then till the attainment of India's independence he was addressed as Sir Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan. He became the Vice President of India in 1952 and in 1962 he became the president of India.

He was an Indian philosopher, academic and statesman. He completed his education at Madras Christian College in 1911. He became Assistant Professor and later Professor of Philosophy at Madras Presidency College then subsequently Professor of Philosophy at the University of Mysore (1918-1921). He became first Indian to hold a Professorial Chair at the University of Oxford.

His philosophy was grounded in Advaita Vedanta, reinterpreting this tradition for a contemporary understanding.

## **C.V. Raman House “Yellow House”**

Sir Chandrashekhara Venkata Raman, was born on 7<sup>th</sup> November 1888. He was an Indian Physicist born in the former Madras Province in India (presently the state of Tamil Nadu), who carried out ground breaking work in the field of light scattering, which earned him the 1930 Nobel prize for Physics and was the first person in Asia to obtain said award for achievements in science. He discovered that when light traverses a transparent material some of the deflected light changes wavelength and amplitude. The phenomenon subsequently known as Raman Scattering, results from the Raman Effect. In the year 1954, the Indian government honoured him with India's highest civilian award the Bharat Ratna.

In the year 1917, Raman resigned from his government service after he was appointed the first Palit Professor of Physics at the University of Calcutta.



Raman was married on 6<sup>th</sup> May 1907 to Zokasundari Amma (1892-1980). They had two sons, Chandrashekhara and radio-astronomer Radhakrishnan. Throughout his life, Raman developed an extensive personal collection of stones, minerals and materials with interesting light scattering properties, which he obtained from his world travels and as a gift.

The colour yellow stands for freshness, happiness, positivity, clarity, energy, optimism, enlightenment, remembrance, intellect, honor, loyalty and joy.

Yellow is the most luminous of all the colours of the spectrum. It is the colour that captures our attention more than any other colour. In almost every culture yellow represents sunshine, happiness and warmth.

She was awarded the Kaisar-E-Hind medal by the British Government for her work during the plague epidemic in India. She was listed among 150 leading women in a list by the University of London.

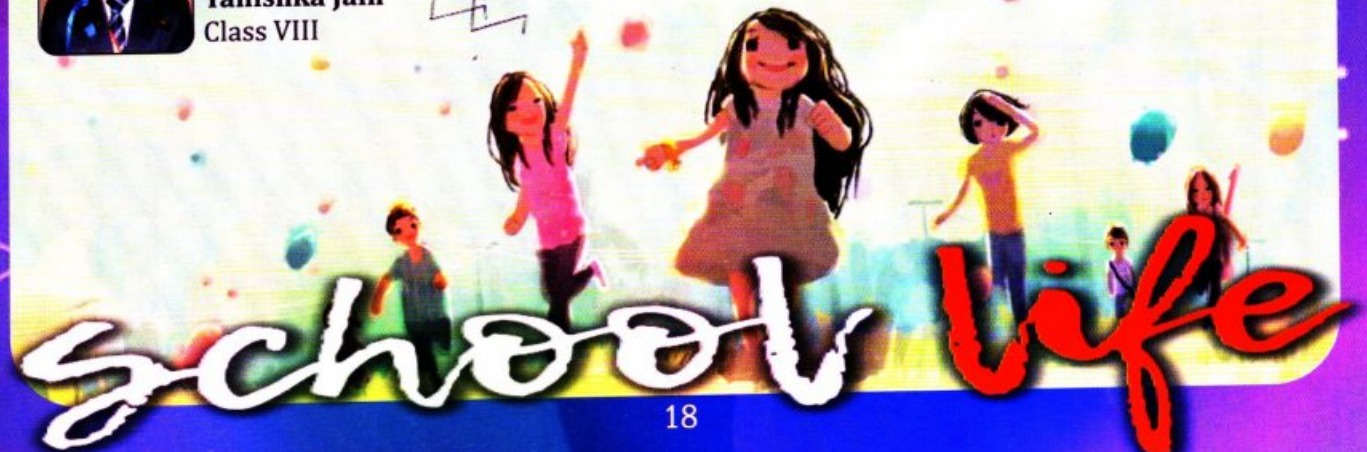

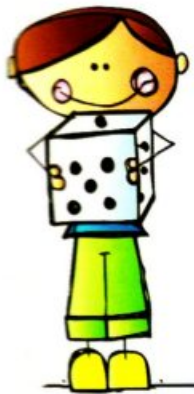

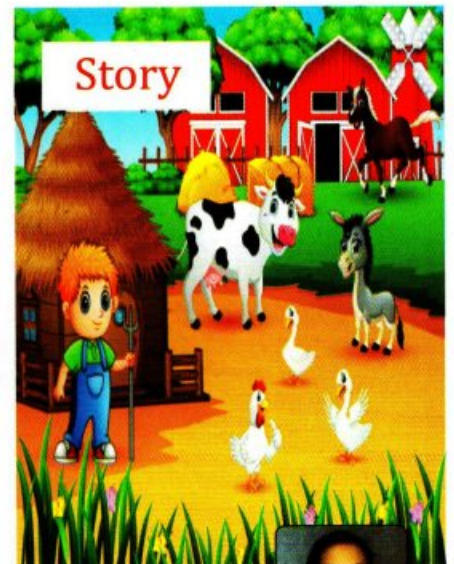
The judge asked the farmer if he was using any measure to weight the butter. The farmer replied, "Honor, I am primitive. I don't have a proper measure, but I do have a scale."

- The first single celled organism appeared on earth 3500 million years ago in the Precambrian era.
- Reptiles evolved during the Permian period as they were able to spread all over the world because land joined as a huge continent and insects and millipedes were also able to move onto the land. This was possible for the earth's temperature had cooled enough for land plants to row in large number providing food.
- Hylonomus was one of the earliest known reptiles.
- The Miller-Urey experiment attempts to recreate the chemical conditions of the primitive earth in the laboratory and synthesized some of the building blocks of life. This experiment is considered to be the classic experiment on the origin of life. It was conducted in 1953 by Stanley L. Miller and Harold C. Urey at the University of Chicago.



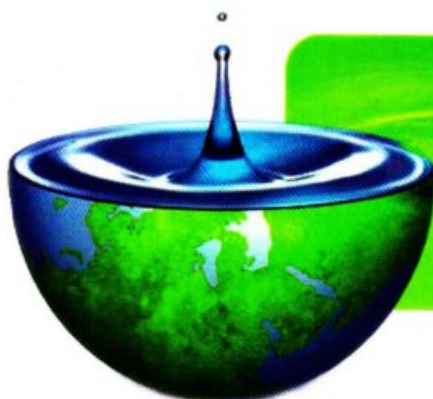

## Twinkling of Stars

If you look at the stars on a clear night, you will notice that they seem to twinkle and that they differ greatly in brightness. A much slower movement also takes place in the right sky. If you map the location of several stars for a few hours, you will observe that all the stars revolve slowly about a single point in the sky.

Twinkling of stars is caused by movements in earth's atmosphere. Starlight enters the atmosphere as straight rays. Twinkling occurs because air movements constantly change the path of the light as it comes through the air. How bright a star looks when viewed from earth depends on two factors - the actual brightness of stars and the distance of the star from the earth.

A nearby star that is actually dim can appear brighter than a distant star that is really extremely brilliant, for example alpha centauri and seems to be slightly brighter than a star known as Rigel.

Alpha centauri and seems brighter because it is only 1/325 as far from earth as Rigel is 4.4 light years for Alpha centauri and 1,400 light for Rigel.

The scientific name for the twinkling of stars is stellar scintillation. Stars twinkle when we see them from the earth's surface because we are viewing them through thick layers of turbulent air in the earth's atmosphere stars appear as tiny dots in the sky.

Stars closer to the horizon appear to twinkle more than stars that are overhead. This is because the light of stars near the horizon has to travel through more air than the light of stars overhead and so is subject to more refraction, also planets do not usually twinkle, because they are so close to us; they appear big enough that the twinkling is not noticeable.

# Archaeology

Archaeology is the branch of the humanities and social sciences that studies the material remains of humankind and is concerned with tools and other artefacts of human culture.

Archaeology is a wide-ranging subject that covers a time span of at least 3 million years from the first appearance of humankind to the present day.

There are two main types of archaeologies; the archaeology of everything preceding the earliest period of recorded history (prehistoric archaeology) and the archaeology from the appearance of writing onwards (text-aided archaeology).

The only source for knowledge of humankind during the prehistoric period of roughly 3 million years is archaeology – the material remains. Both archaeology and written sources are combined to produce an account of human culture.

Archaeologists attempt to reconstruct the past by analysing, dating and comparing excavated sites and artefacts. Specialist fields include Egyptology, Mesopotamian, classical archaeology, medieval archaeology and American archaeology.

As a methodology, archaeology has many aspects and requires experts such as geologists, geophysicists, mineralogists, botanists, zoologists, physical anthropologists, chemists, physicists and others.

In recent years a specialized field called salvage archaeology has developed in response to the need for the quick recovery and research of finds resulting from urban expansion and modernisation projects throughout the world.

The purpose of archaeological excavation is to discover the basic sequence of occupation of a site and to examine various aspects of the artefacts and other remains. Archaeologists study the structure, dimensions and scarification of the terrain by combining horizontal and vertical cross sections.

Hodder Westropp (1866) proposed the term 'Mesolithic' making European prehistory a five-fold system of old stone age (Mesolithic Period), New Stone Age (Neolithic Period), Bronze Age and Iron Age.

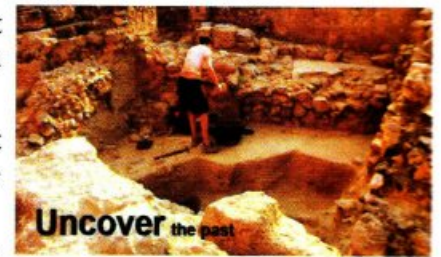

# Mission Chandrayaan-2



**C**handrayaan-2 is an Indian lunar mission to explore the uncharted south pole of the celestial body by landing a rover. On September 7, India attempted to make a soft landing on to the lunar surface. India's Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle, GSLV MkIII-M1 had successfully launched the 3,840 Kg Chandrayaan-2 spacecraft into the earth's orbit on July 22.

Chandrayaan-2 satellite had begun its journey towards the moon leaving the earth's orbit in the dark hours on August 14, after a crucial maneuver called Trans Lunar Insertion (TLI) that was carried out by ISRO to place the spacecraft on "Lunar Transfer Trajectory".

In a major milestone for India's second Moon mission, the Chandrayaan-2 spacecraft had successfully entered the lunar orbit on August 20 by performing Lunar Orbit Insertion (LOI) maneuver. On August 22, ISRO released the first image of the moon captured by Chandrayaan-2. On September 2, 'Vikram' successfully separated from the orbiter, following which two de-orbiting manoeuvres were performed to bring the lander closer to the moon.

## 'Vikram' and 'Pragyan'

As India attempted a soft landing on the lunar surface on September 7, all eyes were on the lander 'Vikram' and 'Pragyan'.

The 1,471 Kg 'Vikram' named after Vikram Sarabhai, father of the Indian space programme, was designed to execute a soft landing on the lunar surface, and to function for one lunar day, which is equivalent to about 14 earth days.

Chandrayaan-2's 27 Kg robotic vehicle 'Pragyan', which translates to 'wisdom' in Sanskrit, can travel up to 500 metres from the landing spot on the moon and leverages solar energy for its functioning. If successful, Pragyan will roll out from inside the lander to carry out an intense probe of the moon soil with its two payloads. Chandrayaan, which means "moon vehicle" in Sanskrit, exemplifies the resurgence of international interest in space. The US, China and private corporations are among those racing to explore everything from resource mining to extraterrestrial colonies on the moon and even Mars.

The primary objective of the Chandrayaan-2 lander were to demonstrate the ability to soft-land on the lunar surface and operate a robotic rover on the surface. Scientific goals include orbital studies of lunar topography, minerology, elemental abundance, the lunar exosphere and signatures of hydroxyl and water ice. The orbiter will map the lunar surface and help to prepare 3D maps of it.

the size of its vocabulary, the quality of its literature throughout history, and its association with great cultures or religions, are all important factors in the popularity of any language.

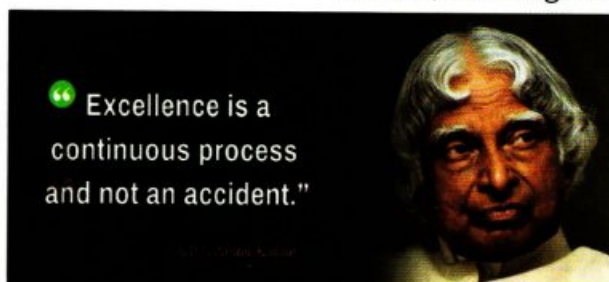

## A Pink Headed Duck: An Extinct Bird

Extinction of a particular animal or plant species occurs when there are no more individual of same species alive anywhere in the world – the species has died out. This is the natural part of evolution, but sometimes extinctions happen at a much faster ratio than usual.

The pink headed duck is one of such extinct bird (animal) was found in parts of the Gangetic plains of India, Bangladesh and the riverine swamps region of Myanmar but feared extinct since the 1950s. Numerous searches have failed to provide any proof of continued existence. It has been suggested that it may exist in the inaccessible Swamp regions of northern Myanmar and some sightings report from the region have led to its status being declared as "Critically Endangered" rather than extinct.

It is unique in the pink colouration of head combined with a dark body. A prominent wing patch and the long slender neck are features shared with the common Indian spot-billed duck. The eggs have also been held as particularly peculiar in being nearly spherical.

जय हिन्द जय भारत।।

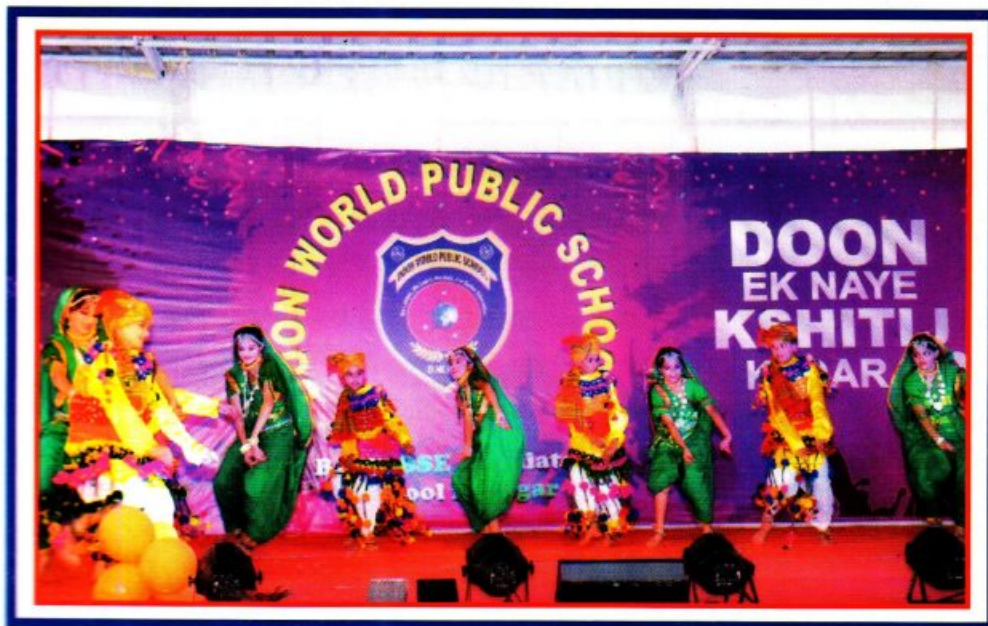
